With over 1/2 million visitors, 10 thousand arriving aircraft, 2,830 show planes, 777 exhibitors, and 66 countries represented, the 2010 Oshkosh AirVenture was fantastically huge. Do you know that Main Street in Historic downtown Clayton hosts one of the best grower's market in the country? **Simply Homegrown Market** is an outdoor produce and value added item market with all the class and variety of goods one would hope to find anywhere. Each Saturday from 9-noon about a dozen growers showcase the finest items from their gardens.

Simply Homegrown Market is just that—nine years ago, a group of about six growers came together to sell their homegrown items. Each week you will find a wonderful selection that may include pickles, jellies, honey, chutneys, grains, cheeses, cut flowers, and of course, freshly picked items from the local small farms. Participating growers are currently all from Rabun County. All their items and ingredients are grown or created on their farms. At the market, customers will find a flyer outlining how each grower produces their items and farm practice details. Many venders are certified organic. "We are local people with small sustainable farms in Rabun County" states SHGM spokesman, Joe Gatins, a.k.a. the "Garlic Guy". "We guarantee it [the produce] wasn't in a truck for two weeks."
