Restricted Runway Hours—September 13-14

Please note, due to the racing event occurring the weekend of September 13-14, the Heaven's Landing runway will be open for arrivals and departures during limited hours only.

Open times:

September 13—midnight to 6:00am and 6:00pm to midnight.

September 14—midnight to 6:00am and after 6:00pm

On both days there will be a short window from 12 noon until 1pm (racing lunch break).

Aircraft movement on the ramp will be highly restricted for the entire weekend.

Connections

Heaven's Landing is delighted to announce the completion of the runway-taxiway connector at the northeast end of the field. With the addition of the tie-in, the Heaven's Landing runway is now 5200 feet long.

The tie-in expansion eliminates any need for back-taxiing and enhances what is already a stunningly beautiful airfield. Developer Mike Ciochetti says the project had been in the works, but a partnership with wannaGOFAST and Heaven's Landing made the completion a reality in time for the third wannaGOFAST Shootout scheduled for September 13 and 14.



Construction work took place in the early morning hours and didn't disrupt any traffic to the runway.

Museum of Aviation—Warner Robins, GA

The Museum of Aviation at Robins Air Force Base in Warner Robins, GA celebrates 30 years on November 9. The Museum of Aviation is the second largest United States Air Force aviation museum in the nation. The facility houses 80 aircraft inside and out, fantastic exhibits including those dedicated to Vietnam veterans, Brig. Gen Robert L. Scott, Jr., and Tuskegee Airmen to name a few.



The Museum of Aviation is also home to the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame where Heaven's Landing's own, Connie and Ed (1935-2014) Bowlin were enshrined in 2009.


